The School is affiliated to C.B.S.E New Delhi, in the year 2008 and it imparts quality education without distinction of caste and creed.

## **The Management:**

The advisory board of Kanachur Academy of General Education includes well known personalities in the field of education, Prof. Dr. M. Abdul Rahiman former vice chancellor of Kannur and Calicut universities is the Chairman of the advisory board. Prof. Dr. Rameela Shekhar, Professor of Child and Adolescence mental health at the School of Social work, Roshini Nilaya and several others are the members. I am ever grateful to these eminent personalities for their invaluable guidance, direction, support and encouragement.

## **Students, teaching & non-teaching staff:**

Kanachur public School which started with 47 students, 3 teachers & 4 administrative staff now has student strength of about 1100 from K.G to X std and 56 well qualified, experienced, trained and dedicated teachers and 69 hard working non teaching Staff. The present strength is 90 Boys and 81 Girls in the Pre School Section. 532 Boys and 396 Girls are there in the classes from 1 to 10<sup>th</sup>. The Unique feature of Kanachur Public School is that the, Teacher student ratio is 1:20

**Pre School:** The academic year began with theme based colourful class rooms & additional nursery class kids below 3.5 years with ample facilities to nourish and nurture the young kids.

A preschool plays an important role in molding the child and forming the base for his or her Education.

**Welcome of Tiny Tots:** The fresher's confidently walked onto the stage for the first time of their lives on 26<sup>th</sup> July. An Orientation programme was conducted for parents by K T Shwetha.

Colour day was celebrated every month for the Pre school students so that they learn colours through practical experience.

Here at Kanachur Pre School, the Kindergarten wing of Kanachur Public School our aim is to make everyday a learning day, filled with new and wonderful experiences.

The environment of our preschool is very different from the monotonous atmosphere of a school that teaches just ABC's.

**Facilities:** We know that Learning doesn't happen inside the four walls of a classroom and to facilitate experiential learning we have specially designed infrastructure with all the facilities for the all round development of all the students.

**Library:** There is no friend as loyal as a book. Books are the windows through which the soul looks out into this wide world. One can travel through time forward or backward with the help of books. To help the students enjoy this magic world of books, every year we update the library with essential and popular titles, we subscribe for a wide variety of magazines & newspapers in English and Kannada. Presently our library consists of about 8500 volumes of books.

**Computer lab:** Our computer lab has more than 25 computers which gives hands on experience to our students in the field of information technology.

**Laboratories:** "Tell me & I will forget, Show me and I may remember, Involve me and I will understand" – Says a Chinese proverb. Here we involve the students in Science activities so that they will not only remember but will also understand the concepts clearly. The well equipped Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Maths Lab provide experiential learning to our students for creating better student engagement levels and core subjects understanding.

**Play Ground:** To keep students physically fit and to help them build a healthy physique. We have a vast **play ground** with a 200mts track, Volleyball, throw ball, Kho - Kho, Kabaddi etc... which provides ample opportunities for our students to develop their physique. To train the students in various games & sports we have 3 physical education teachers. There is a proposal for skating and basket ball courts also.

**English Language lab:** At present we are making use of our computer lab for Assessment of Speaking and Listening skills. This would further enhance the teaching-learning process of the international language and the language skill in English. We are in the process of creating complete language lab with the necessary software for the same.

**Smart Class:** This year thanks to our Management especially our Correspondent Mr. Abdul Rahiman Sir. Smart classes were reinstalled for 12 Class Rooms and Training session for the teachers was conducted on 10<sup>th</sup> Dec 2016. I hope this will help our students have a very good audio visual based learning exposure.

**Celebrations:** To make the students aware of our country's rich heritage, traditional and history and inculcate feelings of patriotism and pride in our nation, the national festivals like Independence Day, Republic day, Teachers day, Gandhi Jayanthi, Hindi week etc are celebrated. We remain active throughout the year through human resource development activities like cultural programs, literary and sports activities.

As per CBSE guidelines we do celebrate Constitution day, National Mathematics day, National Unity Day to imbibe the feelings of National Integration in our students.

- ✓ We celebrate a variety of days to create awareness among our students. Example World Ocean Day, Environmental Day, World Day against Child Labor. We call experts in different fields to give hands on experience & in depth knowledge for our students. Some such occasions are;
