Parental attention to study and related matters:

- The C.B.S.E. Curriculum is quite demanding and parents are to take keen interest in their child's academic performance.
- It has been made mandatory this year to make students do Physical Exercise as prescribed in the CBSE syllabus. In the beginning students may feel tired or discomfort. Parents and students are requested to cooperate in this regard. If your child has a medical problem, please submit a medical certificate to the school.
- Parents must watch and guide their children's studies at home. Children need constant attention and encouragement to enable them to improve their performance.
- Please do not allow your child to use, play, or waste time on the mobile.
- In case a student absents herself/himself from periodic test, term exams or pre board, he/she will be marked zero.(except in grave circumstances, where decision is left with the Principal)
- Encourage the child to read good books, newspaper and to watch News on T.V.
- Students are encouraged to compulsorily participate in any one co-curricular activity organized by the school.
- Parents should see that their children do not bring money or valuable articles with them. The school will not be responsible for books, money or other articles that are lost. It may be noted that any violation of this rule will be viewed very seriously.
- Parents should see that their children do not bring iPod, cameras, mobile phones or similar electronic gadgets to the school. There will be surprise checking of the students and their belongings and if a student is found with any of these gadgets, the same will be confiscated and returned only at the end of the year after collecting a fine. Any violation of this rule will attract strict disciplinary action.
- Parents are requested not to enter the classrooms and meet individual teachers during the class hours. Parents, who wish to meet teachers regarding the progress of their wards, may do so after class hours, i.e. **3.30 p.m. to 4.00 p.m** (Monday to Friday). Contact, help desk and take permission from the Principal or Co-ordinator before meeting the teachers. Please come by **3.30 p.m.** as teachers leave the premises at **4.00 p.m.**

- Parents are requested not to arrange programmes for their children during school time. Children will not be allowed to go anywhere during school hours. Students will not be allowed to absent themselves for long period.
- Parents should avoid phoning the school to talk to children or teachers during school hours. However, in case of emergency, message received on the phone will be conveyed to them.
- Parents must take the child home promptly after class. The school authorities are not responsible for the safety of any student after school hours or before **8.50 AM**.
- Parents/guardians are requested to respond to the calls from the school positively.
- Parents are requested not to abuse or insult the teachers. If you have a problem, bring it to the notice of the Principal.
- All students must speak in English in the school premises as well as in the school bus also. A fine will be levied if they fail to do so.
- Students are not permitted to ride two wheeler motor vehicles / drive four wheelers. Strict action will be taken if they do so.
- Bullying, teasing girl students, use of foul language and stealing are punishable offences and may result in rustication of the student concerned
- Chewing chicklets and chewing gums in the school premises is strictly forbidden. A heavy fine will be levied.
- Ensure that your child reaches the school after **8:50 AM** and before the bell rings at **9.10 AM**. The child should not enter the school till the staff arrive. Your child should be taken home by **4.00 PM**. School will not be responsible for the child after **4.00PM**.
- Students should always be clean and neatly dressed in well pressed uniform, polished shoes, trimmed clean nails and combed hair. The uniform is to be worn on all school days and all functions.
- Girls should wear petticoat and tights. Girls should wear black decent hair ribbons. Colourful ribbons or hair bands are not permitted. Students are not permitted to wear long dangling earrings or any gold jewelry.

- Boys should wear banyans. Boys should have a short, decent haircut. Students are not allowed to spike / gel their hair, wear nail polish, tattoo or any henna design.
- Students may not go to the toilets during class time. Such needs must be attended during the break. However if any student has a medical problem, the same must be brought to the notice of the class teacher in writing with medical certificate attached.
- Damage done to School property will attract stringent action including a fine.
- Toilets must be flushed after use. Keep your toilets and class rooms clean.
- Even though clean drinking water is available in the school, every student must carry one bottle of drinking water daily.
- Please avoid sending junk food in your children's tiffin to the school. Healthy food will make a healthy child.
- Any damage done in class or around the premises will have to be made good by the pupil. The decision of the Principal regarding the amount to be paid shall be final.
- Every pupil should endeavour to keep up the high standard of the school, by excelling in good manners. Hence, for the smooth running of the school, no student may prove to be a source of disturbance. Strict actions will be taken if a student disturbs the class.
- Pupils suffering from contagious or infectious diseases will not be permitted in school.
- Medical check up will be done in January/ February every year. Please check with your child or class teacher if any medical problem has been detected.
- A record of the addresses of parents / guardians is maintained in the school office and they are requested to communicate any change without delay.
- The engagement of private tutors may prove injurious to the real progress of the student. Parents are requested to check the knowledge method & credentials of the teacher before engaging them.
- Parents must shoulder their responsibilities by co-operating fully in the task of education by seeing to the regular studies of the child and encourage him or her to participate in the activities of the school. They should faithfully attend all school meetings and functions.

The school management reserves the right to add, alter or amend any of these rules.

- Realize the value of time; do not wait till the approach of the examination. The key to success is regular and sincere work. Revise your lessons get your difficulties solved.
- Let there be grace and sense of purpose in your work and movement.
- Be regular for the assembly, and take active part in it.
- Extend your discipline in keeping the class-room and the school campus clean. Don't scatter bits of paper on the floor, should you find any, remove them / neither spoil the walls nor damage the school furniture and other property. They are yours and you have to pass them on to your younger brothers and sisters. Report damage or losses immediately to the class teacher or Principal. Any damage will be made good by the person responsible.
- Running, Playing and Shouting in the class rooms and corridors during study hours is forbidden. Student must not indulge in fights and physical and verbal abuse in school. Stringent action will be taken against all students instigating and participating in such acts.
- Don't loiter around outside the class-room while the school is in session. While moving from one class to other take care not to disturb other classes. Always move in a line.

- If the bus facility is to be withdrawn, 15 days notice should be given and a withdrawal form is to be filled , signature of the principal taken and deposited in the office.
- No vehicles will be allowed inside the main gate either in the morning or in the evening.
- Please drop and pick your child from the main gate.
- Please give your child an umbrella to use even if coming by vehicle including school bus.
- Vehicles will be allowed into the school premises between **10.00 am and 12.00 noon, 1.30 p.m. to 2.30 pm** if visitors are required to meet the office people.
- After **2.30 p.m.** or before **10.00 am** and between **12.00 noon to 01.30 p.m.** no vehicle is allowed inside the school premises.
- In case your child misses the bus at his / her own pick-up point, Kindly make a effort to drop your child at school and not harass the other bus drivers or conductors to pick-up your child and bring him/her to school.
- The bus will run only to stops of each locality and not to the individual houses.
- Students not in time for the bus will have to make their own arrangement on that day to come to school.
- Do not shout/scream in the moving bus.
- Avoid putting out your hand / heard through the window.
- Remain seated in your place till your stop comes.
- Queue for getting into the bus.
- Offer seats to the juniors if enough space is unavailable.
- Indiscipline and foul language and damage will not be tolerated and very strict action will be taken against persistent offenders.
- All students are requested to be at their designated stop 5 minutes prior to the scheduled time.
- The bus will not wait for any late comers.

Birthdays :

Fees

Withdrawal :

All dues must be cleared. Library books and other school property items should be returned before the child is withdrawn and Transfer Certificate is issued.

Duplicate copies of T.C. may be issued on payment of ₹ 200/. All T.C. applications will be processed within a maximum period of 6 days.

The Principal is empowered to effect the withdrawal of a pupil or to remove the name of the pupil from the rolls of the school if, in his/her opinion, the conduct is unsatisfactory or whose parent/guardians shows little interest in the progress of their ward refusing to come to school, or to abide by the rules for other serious reasons.
